We're halfway through the season and there's a lot of excitement yet to come!

We pulled off another Divisional Championship event this month, using an upgraded timing system, new computers, an inventory of shiny new cones (we'd prefer you whack the grungy ones!), 60-second courses by Assistant RE Mason Libby that reached all the way to the far end of the runway. Could've wished for a few more entries but we gave everyone six runs each day.

The back half of our season begins at the end of June with Mirror Khana XLIII. That's an event you don't want to miss. Smack cones without penalty (to a point). No clocks – all you gotta beat is that one other car on the other side of the runway. Everyone gets at least four runs, more if you win matches. It's an adrenaline rush. More information on Page 6.

Then comes July, when we can't schedule events at the BFRA because the LeadSled thing comes to town, so we decamp to Yoder on July 27 for the first round of the Sunflower Solo Showdown against Wichita Region. It's only an hour south just past Hutchinson. Their Road Yoder site is much like ours, a former airfield runway,

perhaps a little bit wider. (Wichita is also doing a Saturday event if you feel like a doubleheader)

We won the Showdown the past two years so let's go for the three-peat! The drive to Yoder isn't much farther than many Salina Region members do to get to Salina, especially those who live south of our city.

August 17 is our turn in the barrel as Wichita comes here to wreak their Sunflower Solo Showdown revenge – but all in good fun and enjoyable camaraderie.

September brings the Solo Nationals. Open registration just began on Tuesday and there's already more than 1250 entries! The entry cap is 1400, 700 on Tuesday-Wednesday and 700 again on Thursday-Friday. If you run Nationals you get points in the Salina Region championship, plus bonus points for drivers you beat.

And the weekend right after, Sept. 6-7, we're doing a doubleheader hoping a few homeward bound Nationals drivers might stop by to enjoy our concrete. Each day is a separate points event.

We finish the year off with Octoberfast 36 on Oct. 12 – the annual event with the sorta-kinda same course that was first designed in 1990. And then the season finale Nov. 2, the day we go back to Central Standard Time. You get an extra hour of sleep before the event.

The calendar is on Page 2, as always. Registration is open on MotorsportsReg.com for all the Salina Region events except November, which will be added soon.

So mark your calendar, air up your tires and plan ahead for the last half of the year. *It's race day!*

# Solo Performance Specialties/R&S Racing Midwest Division Solo Series

Salina Region was host for Rounds 3 and 4 of the Midwest Division Solo Series, with drivers from Wichita, Kansas, Kansas City, Ozark Mountain, NeOkla and one claiming Mid-South Region (Memphis) although that's Doug Gill who lives in Topeka now and is a frequent visitor.

Mason Libby set up a busy and challenging course for Saturday, then ran it the opposite direction on Sunday with some minor changes. Six runs each day.

One oddity is that not a single class, either day, was decided by less than one second. Saturday's closest match was B Street Prepared between Steven Allen's BMW M3 from Wichita Region and our own Andlee Phengphachanh's Toyota AllTrac, decided by 1.040 sec. Both of them did their best times



on their fourth runs. Next-closest was H Street, Dennis Smith 1.414 sec quicker than Don Herrick.

Sunday's closest match was C Street, a father-son Dunham family duel in a Honda S2000 from Kansas Region. Dad Greg was 1.889 sec quicker than 16-year-old Hank. Second-closest on Sunday was BSP again, but this time Andlee was the victor by 1.955 sec over Preston Evans of Kansas City Region in an M3

Largest class was E Street, an all-Miata showdown of seven cars on Saturday and eight on Sunday but dominated both days by Matthew Eaton, NeOkla Region, who posted a 2.5 sec victory margin on Saturday and 1.8 sec on Sunday. Second/third were Zachary Nusbaum and Nathan Jones-Walker from Kansas City Region sharing a car – Zach quicker on Saturday, Nate quicker on Sunday.

Points for both the Divisional Championship and the Salina Region Championship scored each day as a separate event. This permits people who can only make one day to participate. And while Salina Region awards were given each day, the Divisional awards are based on two-day times. Which is how Andlee ended up winning the weekend in BST. In the big ES class, Matthew Eaton easily took first by a 5-sec margin, while Nusbaum outran his co-driver by a 10th of a sec.

FTD on Saturday fell to XB winner Heath Helmick from KC Region, 56.318, and on Sunday to CAMT winner Opie Viets, Ozark Mountain Region, at 60.775. Fast Lady was ESL winner Sharon Brillhart both days in her MR2. Top PAX went to GS winner Ron Williams on Saturday, ES winner Matthew Eaton on Sunday.

The weekend was also notable for pylons – the nice shiny new ones the region had just acquired, and the fact only one person each day managed to get though without killing any (or taking a DNF). CST winner Luke Scott from Wichita on Saturday, HSL winner Nancy Smith on Sunday.

Divisional points are posted on the Midwest Division website – www.midiv.org. Anyone who has run at least one day of both the Wichita and Salina events (so far) are now qualified for awards with three events yet to go – NeOkla Region at Muskogee June 28-29, Nebraska Region at Lincoln Aug. 2-3, and Kansas Region at Independence, KS Sep. 20-21

You can smack up to three pylons with no penalty, but the fourth one is a DNF. But keep going, what if the other guy hits five? Yes, it happens.

We'll set up brackets for four or five class groupings. The one-on-one aspect, the pylon rule, and the pure adrenaline rush of

trying to beat *that guy* are great equalizers. It's double elimination – you gotta lose twice before you're out.

And just to make it more interesting, there's practice! You get two runs, one from each side, before the eliminations begin. Set up a grudge match if you want. That way everyone gets a minimum four runs, more if you win your pairings.

### • • • Associate memberships • • •

- Associate Memberships in Salina Region expire concurrent with National and Region-of-Record memberships. All Associate memberships paid direct to Salina Region are notified to SCCA Membership and expire on their National expiration date. Associate members are fully-vested members of Salina Region, although their Region-of-Record is elsewhere.
