MEETING MINUTES

(Subject to correction and approval at the next Salina Region board meeting)

Call to Order – by RE Andlee Phengphachanh via Zoom at 7:24 pm, Nov. 18, 2025. Also attending: Sharon Brillhart, Rocky Entriken, Justin Gagna, Phelan Gagnon, Mason Libby, Dennis and Nancy Smith.

Minutes – Sharon moved to approve Oct. 16 minutes, Phelan seconded. Passed.

Treasurers Report – Phelan moved to approve Treasurers Report as presented. Rocky seconded. Passed.

Old Business – Scheduling – Phelan said 2026 schedule will mostly duplicate 2025's. Banquet – Phelan looking at possibility of having it at Flareside Performance, a prep shop north of Salina, home to Central Kansas' only DynoJet 224x chassis dynamometer; but there is no central heating there. Discussion suggested an after-event following a spring or summer solo would be fun. Banquet discussion turned to The Farm in Minneapolis with catering from Minneapolis's Fajitas Mexican Grill. Further information to be developed.

2026 election – Andlee reported using MotorsportsReg to conduct the vote was more complex than anticipated. Plan now is Rocky will conduct the election by email as was done for 2024 and 2025 officers. *Need a candidate to stand for Regional Executive* (Andlee has done it for four years). Mason Libby and Chandler Brown intend to continue as Assistant RE and Secretary. Sharon Brillhart and Phelan Gagnon intend to accept re-appointment as Treasurer and Solo Chair; Andlee would become Past RE – those are the officers mandated in Salina Region Bylaws. We also need a volunteer to take over as equipment manager/trailer wrangler (the position traditionally includes free entry to all local solo events).

New Business – Mirror Khana XLIII was a fun event. Andlee mentioned it ran longer than our usual events, Rocky replied that is typical of Mirror Khana because each run must be started and completed separately, no overlap.

Trailer – It was brought up that certain equipment must be removed from the trailer during winter, including bottles of water, pens, the printer and ink, to avoid exposure to freezing weather.





It was a crisp November morning as the course for Mirror Khana XLIII was being set up, barely above freezing but a rapid warming ensued under a clear sky. An entry of 27 drivers grouped into four brackets – for the first time using the PAX index to create the groupings.

Post-event, Steve Schrag dropped a photo on Salina Region's Facebook page of the "most important button" on his Mustang for running the event. Can't quite make it out? It's the seat warmer!

Mirror Khana needs a few more workers to function so three smaller heats were set up with everyone working two,

driving one. A heat would do its two practice runs, then progress immediately into its competition rounds.



Most important button for running this morning! It was a little tricky running on cold tires, but still a lot of fun. The modifications made to stay away from the dog park still kept with the spirit of the original MirrorKhana course. Thanks to everyone for their hard work through the year putting the events together. I hope everyone has a good off-season.

TOP DOG

The two top brackets went first. Officially Top Dog had the widest PAX spread, 0.878 for the SSM entry to 0.844 for the two CAMS Corvettes, a spread of 0.034 sec. But in reality Mark Walton's SSM Miata (and Theresa's CSP Miata – same car) was barely more than a basic E Street machine. The CP Camaro didn't show, so the real high index was Cameron Kidwell's XB class MX5.

By the time the class reached the semifinals, the Waltons were paired up and went off against a stopwatch, with Theresa's 1:03.22 run just 0.45 sec quicker. Dylan Reed, undefeated in the louder Corvette was waiting, but spun on his match setting up a rerun against Theresa. Dylan kept it true on the rerun to win Top Dog.

BIGBORE

In previous years, "Bigbore" usually meant Mustangs, Camaros and Corvettes, but now the top index was Andlee Phengphachanh's Toyota AllTrac running in B Street Touring. The bracket spread was only 0.008 sec down to the two CAMC Mustangs. And again, a car on the bottom of the spread ended up on top of the results.

That would be Steve Schrag's bun-warmer Mustang, but he had to come through the loser bracket to get there. If two or more cars in a bracket were in the same class, they get paired in the first round so that drivers always get to face same-class competition before being matched with cars of different, possibly higher, classes, so Schrag's

first match was against Brent Holm's CAMC Mustang. Schrag went off course, handing the match to Holm.

Marching through the loser brackets, Schrag took on Nicholas Lake's FSP Focus and Geoff Leazer's CST Miata to reach the quarterfinal. Then he dispatched Tracy Presnell's CST BMW and Chandler Brown's AS Lotus Elise (all of them indexed higher than CAMC) to reach an undefeated Andlee for the final – thus managing to run against every other car in the 7-car bracket.

Schrag's victory forced a runoff, each driver now having lost only once, but

Andlee – leaving nothing on the table – smacked four cones to ensure the Bigbore victory to Schrag's Mustang.

MIDBORE

The PAX spread again was only 0.008 sec from Matt Kramer's CAMT Mustang to the father/son pairing of Greg and Hank Dunham in a CS Honda S2000. But the day would come down to a duel between Mason Libby's second-seeded BS Sky and Robert Clapp's fourth-seeded BMW 335i.

They were paired in the first round. Robert won that match and was unbeaten in the prelims sending him straight to the final, while Mason had to fight through the loser bracket. Greg Dunham won two rounds before losing to Robert, sending him to the semifinals. Meanwhile Mason beat Gary Miller's FS Camaro and young Hank Dunham. In the quarter he eclipsed Abner Perney's FS Nissan, the elder Dunham in the semi and Robert in the final. For the third time, the bracket went to a runoff where Mason repeated for the win.

SMALLBORE

The last bracket had the closest spread. Just two classes, ES and HS, 0.006 apart – and including a Ladies class entry in each class.

No rerun this time. Sharon Brillhart, the ESL entry but on the same index as the open ES class, became the only driver to go fully undefeated on the day. She marched past Rocky Entriken and Jason Rash, both ES Miatae, and Dennis Smith's HS Mini Cooper in the prelims. Dennis went to the semifinals where he outran Jason's Miata but fell again in the final to Sharon's MR2.

You may also join as many other regions as you like, paying their local dues for the purpose of winning local championship points and participating in their programs. These are "Associate" or "Dual Region" memberships. Salina Region's Associate Members are fully-vested members eligible for all our championships, voting rights, region offices and other member benefits. "Associate" membership only means region-of-record is elsewhere.

You <u>must</u> be a member to enter SCCA events. There are several different types of membership available, including Regular, Family, First Gear (under 25) and Military, plus short-term Trial (free) and Weekend (\$15) Memberships. Questions? - Associate Memberships in Salina Region expire concurrent with National and Region-of-Record memberships. All Associate memberships paid direct to Salina Region are notified to SCCA Membership and expire on their National expiration date. Associate members are fully-vested members of Salina Region, although their Region-of-Record is elsewhere.
- Annual dues are \$15.00 both for single memberships and for family memberships (which includes spouse and children age 20 and younger).
- To become an Associate Member of Salina Region, contact SCCA Membership (call 1-800-770-2055) and ask to be included as a member in Salina Region. The Region's dues will be paid at that time and added to your renewal fees.
- Or, at renewal time, renew online and you will find an option to "Add Region." Scroll down to find Salina Region in the drop-down menu.
- If you choose to pay dues direct to Salina Region (for example, at an event), we will notify SCCA and your Salina Region membership will become part of your National membership renewal.
- Mailed subscriptions are available to non-members, \$15 for the calendar year.
